From the Director

Between 1860 and 1948 an officially-sanctioned migration brought about 118,000 children, of whom only 2% were orphans, from Britain to Canada. After a short time at a receiving home, they were placed at factories and farms where some were adopted warmly but many were exploited as child labourers. *Homechild* takes this dark corner of our past and dramatizes its sometimes tragic impact through the generations of one family. Secrets conceal more than facts as Alistair's children learn too well how history's long reach into the heart of a family affects aspiration and even our ability to love. At the same time, MacLeod's story shows us that we can recover even from long-held painful secrets by confronting our demons head on.
